For students not receiving loan funds, summer tuition is due **April 8, 2013**. Otherwise, tuition is due when loan funds disburse.

Note 1: Budgets cannot be increased to cover apartment rent while studying abroad.

- Financial Aid is available in the form of loans. Most students will apply for the Grad Plus, but if you have not borrowed the maximum Federal **Stafford** loans for 2012-2013 you should exhaust those funds first. Please email Janet cromerjb@wfu.edu or Diane Finger fingerdm@wfu.edu to check your eligibility.
- If you borrowed previously the Grad Plus loan send an email at least **five weeks prior** to the start date of the program to, cromerjb@wfu.edu with the program(s) you will attend and the amount of your loan request.
- If you have not borrowed previously a Grad Plus loan then you must go online with the lender at www.studentloans.gov, complete the application and sign the Master Promissory Note at least **five weeks prior** to the start date of the program(s).

Note 2: Loan amounts can be increased to cover the cost of the 4% origination fee charged by the lender.

Note 3: Federal loans cannot disburse more than 10 days before the first day of class.

Refund Dates:

Refund date for the London Program **is Friday, May 31, 2013**.

Refund date for the Venice or Vienna Program **is Friday, June 28, 2013**.

Note 4: For study abroad through other law schools, please provide us with a student budget from that institution's financial aid office, and the name and email of the Financial Aid Director.
