For students not receiving loan funds, summer tuition is due **April 10, 2018**. Otherwise, tuition is due when loan funds disburse.

- Budgets cannot be increased to cover local apartment rent while studying abroad.
- Financial Aid is available in the form of loans. Most students will apply for the Grad Plus, but if you have not borrowed the maximum Federal Stafford loans for 2017-2018 you should exhaust those funds first. Please email lawfinaid@wfu.edu to check your eligibility.
- If you borrowed the Grad Plus loan previously, send an email at least four weeks prior to the start date of the program to lawfinaid@wfu.edu with the program(s) you will attend and the amount of your loan request.
- If you have not borrowed a Grad Plus loan then you must go online with the lender at www.studentloans.gov to sign the Master Promissory Note for Graduate & Professional Students at least four weeks prior to the start date of the program(s). *Please email lawfinaid@wfu.edu when this process is complete.*
- Loan amounts can be increased to cover the cost of the 4.264% origination fee charged by the lender.
- Federal loans cannot disburse more than 10 days before the first day of class.

- For study abroad through other law schools, please provide us with a student budget from that institution's financial aid office, and the name and email of the Financial Aid Director.
